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

DAMME GIVES YOU TIME

In the 13th century, Damme was the linchpin of the Zwin region. In the flourishing outer harbour, goods, such as spices, wine and fish, were transhipped on inland vessels to Bruges and Ghent. Seven hundred years later, little of this international hive of activity is left. Damme lives on a different rhythm now and gives you the time to discover, meet and develop. Both those who live there and those who visit take the given time to look for the things that really matter in life.



TIP

Damme's absolute must-see is the robust **Church of Our Lady** with its characteristic flat tower. From April to September, you can climb the 206 steps to enjoy a wonderful panorama. There is a phenomenal view of the 17th-century city walls, the Damme Canal and the extensive polder landscape.
