The capital of horses of Belgium possesses many extra assets! Downtown you can find the protected city park Baron Casier with a restored carriage house where local creatives exhibit their art. At the **HIPPO.WAR** visitor centre you discover everything about the role of horses and the Americans during The Great War. You can find photographs, film clips and audio files, authentic pieces, an interactive quiz and even a reconstructed horse hospital.

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## Flanders Field American Cemetery

is the only World War I American military cemetery in Belgium. 368 soldiers found their last resting place in Waregem and another 43 are mentioned on the Wall of the Missing. At the visitor centre you can find out more about the story behind the fallen soldiers.
